

# **TRADE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF MALAWI AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA**

## **PREAMBLE**

The Government of the Republic of .South Africa and the Government of the Republic of Malawi -

RECOGNISING that they have a common interest in the further expansion of trade between their respective countries; and

RECOGNISING, also, that it is desirable that such an expansion of the trade between their respective countries should be pursued with due regard, inter alia, to the needs of the two Parties to accelerate their economic development, to diversify their economies and to obtain improved opportunities for access to each Party's market;

HEREBY agree on the following arrangements which are designed to ensure that the trade between their respective countries shall be as free and uninterrupted as possible.

## **ARTICLE 1**

(1). In this Agreement, unless inconsistent with the context -

"South Africa" means the area in respect of which the Government of the Republic of South Africa is a contracting party to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade;

"Malawi" means the area in respect of which the Government of the Republic of Malawi is a contracting party to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade;

"Party" means, a Party to this Agreement namely, the Government of the Republic of South Africa or the Government of the Republic of Malawi;

"Permit" means a licence or permit, issued in writing by or on behalf of a Party, giving conditional or unconditional authority to import goods into, or export goods from, the country of that party; and

Cognate expressions shall be construed accordingly.

(2). The Annexures to this Agreement shall be read with and form an integral part thereof.

## **ARTICLE 2**

Subject to the provisions of this Agreement, the Government of the Republic of South Africa shall allow all goods grown, produced or manufactured in Malawi to be imported into South Africa free of customs duty.

## **ARTICLE 3**

(1). Goods, appertaining to the categories enumerated in Part I of Annexure A with reference to the customs tariff nomenclature as provided for in the appropriate statutory provisions of South Africa, when grown, produced or manufactured in Malawi, shall be imported into South Africa under the authority of an import permit issued by the Director-General of the Department of Agricultural Economics and Marketing of the Republic of South Africa: Provided that under normal trade and market conditions, in any calendar year import permits shall be issued for quantities of not less than -

(a) 300 000 kilograms of unmanufactured tobacco;

(b) 750 metric tons of groundnuts, shelled or in the shell; and

(c) 100 metric tons of processed groundnuts.

(2) Goods appertaining to the categories enumerated in Part II of Annexure A with reference to the customs, tariff nomenclature as provided-for in the appropriate statutory provisions of South Africa, when grown, produced or manufactured in Malawi\* shall be imported into South Africa under the authority of an import permit issued by the Director-general of the Department of Trade and Industry of the Republic of South Africa.

## **ARTICLE 4**

(1) Subject to the provisions of this Agreement, the Government of the Republic of Malawi shall allow all goods grown, produced, or manufactured in South Africa to be imported into Malawi subject to the most-favoured-nation rate of duty provided for under Column 6 of Part III of the Customs Tariff of Malawi.

(2) Goods, appertaining to the categories enumerated in Annexure B with reference to the customs tariff nomenclature as provided for in the appropriate statutory provisions of Malawi, when grown, produced or manufactured In South Africa, shall be imported into Malawi under the authority of an import permit.

## **ARTICLE 5**

The Government of the Republic of South Africa shall allow rough and uncut diamonds produced in South Africa to be exported to Malawi free of export duty subject to a certificate being issued by the appropriate official of the Government of the Republic of Malawi to the effect that such diamonds are to be imported for industrial use in Malawi.

## **ARTICLE 6**

Goods shall not be regarded as having been produced or manufactured -

(1) in South Africa, unless the last process of manufacture shall have been performed in South Africa and as may be prescribed from time to time under the customs legislation of Malawi for the purpose of determining the entitlement of goods to preferential rates of duty, such goods:

- (a) Contain not less than the "specified country content"; or
- (b) Have been subjected in South Africa to a Specified process of manufacture.

(2) In Malawi, unless at least twenty-five per cent, or such other lower percentage as may from time to time be agreed upon between the Parties in respect of specified goods manufactured in Malawi, of the production cost of those goods shall be represented by materials produced and labour performed in Malawi and the last process in the production or manufacture of such goods shall have taken place in Malawi.

## **ARTICLE 7**

(1). A Party may impose anti-dumping duties on goods grown, produced or manufactured in the territory of the other Party and imported into the territory of the Party imposing such duties.

(2). A Party may impose countervailing duties on any goods exported to its territory from the territory of the oilier Party, in order to offset any subsidies granted, directly or indirectly, by such other Party or by other bodies or individuals, in respect of such goods.

(3). The Parties shall co-operate with and assist each other with a view to facilitating investigations into any allegation of dumping or breach or attempted breach of their customs and excise legislation.

## **ARTICLE 8**

In the event of a Party introducing a duty of excise or surtax applicable to goods grown, produced or manufactured in its territory, or increasing a duty of excise or surtax already imposed on goods grown, produced or manufactured in its territory, it may simultaneously levy on similar goods grown, produced or manufactured in the territory of the other Party when imported into the territory of the first-mentioned Party, a corresponding customs duty equivalent to the new or increased duty of excise or surtax.

## **ARTICLE 9**

In the event of a Party introducing a general surcharge on any goods imported into its territory, the introduction of such surcharge shall not be regarded as being a violation of any of the provisions of this Agreement.

## **ARTICLE 10**

Each Party shall use its best endeavors to promote the simplification of its customs procedures with a view to facilitating -

- (a) Trade and tourism between their respective countries;
- (b) The entry of all trade samples; and
- (c) The transit through its territory of goods consigned to and from the territory of the other Party;

## **ARTICLE 11**

Each Party shall enact such legislative measures as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Agreement.

## **ARTICLE 12**

(1) If any product which is the subject of a concession in terms of the provisions of this Agreement, is being imported into the territory of a Party in such increased quantities and under such conditions as to cause or threaten serious injury to domestic producers in such territory of like or directly competitive products, the Party into whose territory the products are imported shall, subject to paragraph (2), be free to suspend the relevant concession in whole or in part or to withdraw or modify the concession.

(2) Before a Party shall take action pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (1), it shall give notice in writing to the other Party as far in advance as may be practicable and shall afford such other Party an opportunity to consult with it in respect of the proposed action. In critical circumstances, where delay in acting pursuant to paragraph (1), would cause damage which would be difficult to repair, proof of which shall be furnished by the Party taking such action, action pursuant to paragraph (1) may be taken provisionally without prior consultation, provided that consultations shall be conducted immediately after such action.

(3) If agreement between the Parties with respect to action pursuant to paragraph (1), is not reached, the Party which proposes to take or continue such action shall, nevertheless be free- to do so.

## **ARTICLE 13**

(1). Without prejudice to the provisions of Article 12, a Party who proposes to take or authorize action which it considers may affect any benefit accruing to the other Party under this Agreement shall, whenever possible, consult in advance with and give sympathetic consideration to any representations by, or proposals received from, the other Party.

(2). A Party shall be free at all times to approach the other Party for consultations with a view to finding ways and means to solve any difficulty or problem in the operation of this Agreement.

(3). Apart from any discussions which may take place under the provisions of paragraphs (1) and (2), the Parties shall meet at intervals not exceeding 15 (fifteen) months, for formal discussion of the operation of this Agreement.

#### **ARTICLE 14**

On the coming into operation of this Agreement, the provisions of all former agreements relating to trade between the countries of the Parties shall cease to have force or effect.

#### **ARTICLE 15**

(1) This Agreement shall enter into force on the date of signature hereof and may be terminated by either Party giving 12 (twelve) months' written notice to the other Party through the diplomatic channel.

(2) Any amendment to this Agreement agreed upon by the Parties shall be effected by Exchange of Notes between them.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto, acting through their representatives thereunto duly authorized, have caused this Agreement in the English language to be signed in duplicate in their respective names at Cape Town on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of June in this Year Nineteen Hundred and Ninety.
